## **LIVE FIRING AREA (LFA)**

With effect from 1 Sep 2006, in order to facilitate the movement of harbour and pleasure craft in the West Johor Straits within the port limits of Singapore, a 75-metre wide sea lane will be designated, adjacent to the port limits, from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Link to Sarimbun. (Please refer to the chartlet at Appendix A.) The 75-metre wide sea lane will be adjacent to the SAFTI Live Firing Area. No unauthorised vessels or persons may enter or remain within the Live Firing Area.

- To ensure safety of navigation the Port Master, pursuant to Section 43 (c) of the Maritime and Port Authority Act (Cap 170), hereby declares that no vessel or craft is to anchor, loiter or conduct any type of fishing activity within this 75-metre wide navigable sea lane adjacent to the Live Firing Area.
