The 20th SMU-RM Western Circuit Sailing Regatta (WCSR) took place over the weekends of 19, 20 and 26 August. This 85-boat regatta, attracted many local and international sailors. Raffles Marina (RM) was abuzz during the three days as the event featured Keelboats, Multihulls, SB20s, PYs, J24's, Access 2.3's for disabled sailors and six Windsurfing classes.

This year's event was filled with adrenaline pumping racing, post-race parties, charity auctions for Sailability Singapore and a recycling project! For the first time at WCSR, organisers from SMU supported the "Turn the Tide on Plastic" campaign by the United Nations – with hopes to reduce the amount of pollution in our waters. Sailors and Windsurfers were encouraged to recycle their aluminum cans and plastic waste such as plastic bottles used during the races. Recycling bins were placed around the marina to promote recycling over the three days.

Day 1 and 2 saw challenging races along the Western Johor Straits from all categories, including Access 2.3 Dinghies by Sailability Singapore and the Windsurfers. The final race day enjoyed plenty of sunshine, light winds and flat waters.

The podium spots were still up for contention. Later that evening, sailors enjoyed a sumptuous buffet dinner with an impressive line-up of performances at the gala dinner and charity auction. SMU's Ardiente wowed the crowd with their Latin ballroom dance moves whilst the institute's VOIX charmed their way into everyone's hearts with two a cappella pieces.

The highlight of the evening was the lively charity auction, which received overwhelming support from the sailors. This year was rather unique as the marina received two sculptures, courtesy of Art Porters for a silent auction. All proceeds and donations went directly to Sailability Singapore. Thereafter, overall prizes were presented by Dr Low Chin Nam, Executive Director of NSL Ltd and Mr Peter Lim, Honorary Advisor of Singapore Sailing Federation, and the President's Cup presented by Professor Arnoud De Meyer, President of SMU.
