ADVISORY FOR RAFFLES MARINA BOATING COMMUNITY

Due to the security climate, it is paramount for us to work closely together to keep our waters safe and secure. We seek your cooperation and understanding to ensure the following are adhered to when you sail out:

- a) Bring along all essential documents including
- National Registration Identity Card / Singapore Driving Licence / Work Permit / Passport (for foreigners)
 - Powered Pleasure Craft Driving License (PPCDL) issued by the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA)
 - Pleasure Craft Licence (issued by MPA)
 - Immigration Clearance (issued by ICA) for foreign-flagged craft
 - Cruising Permit (issued by MPA) for foreign flagged craft to cruise within the port limits of Singapore
 - Port Clearance (issued by MPA) for foreign-flagged craft
- b) Ensure the Automated Identification System (AIS) / Harbour Craft Transponder System (HARTS) on board the craft is switched on and in working order
- c) Keep clear of the Singapore Armed Forces Live Firing Areas along the West Johor Strait (*refer to Maritime and Port Authority Of Singapore (MPA) Port Marine Circular No. 15 of 2006 dated 22 August 2006, Live Firing Area (LFA) <http://www.mpa.gov.sg>*)
