On behalf of the Club Management, we thank you for your participation at Raffles Marina's third-ever Optimist Regatta.

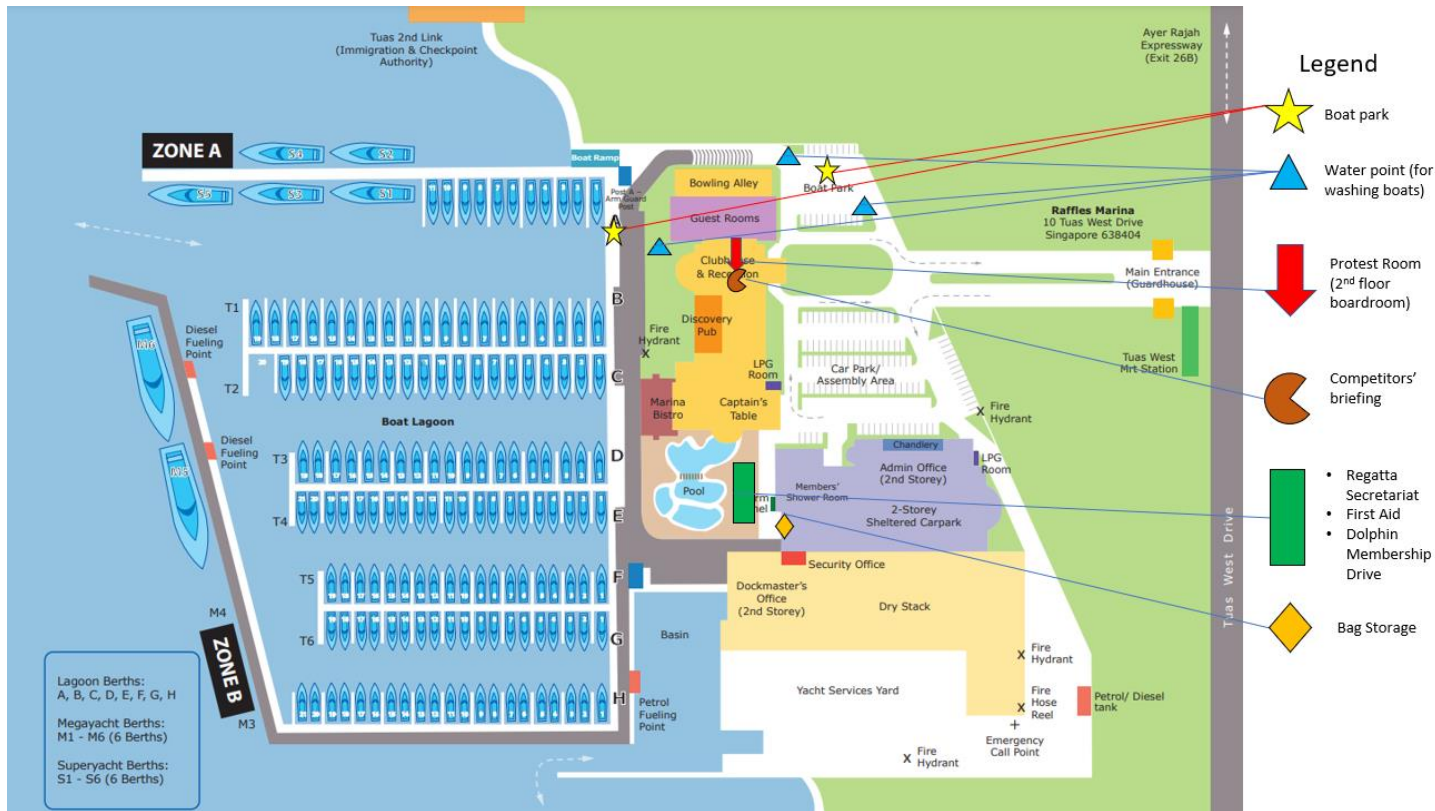

Club Rules

- No wet apparel is allowed inside the main clubhouse.
- Please do not wash your sailing gear in the toilet sinks.
- Please respect the shared areas in the club and keep volumes down.



Safe Management Measures

• Mask Wearing

Mask wearing will continue to be required for **indoor** settings but will be optional in outdoor settings.

- a. For **indoor** activities, masks may be taken off when performing strenuous activity or as part of a class requirement but will have to be put on after the completion of such strenuous sporting and physical activity/class and during rest breaks.
 - b. For **outdoor** activities, individuals are encouraged to wear their masks for personal protection and to protect others, especially in crowded area.
- Competitors born 31st December 2010 or before are required to be fully vaccinated.
 - Medically illegible (MI) and unvaccinated children born 2010 and younger are exempted from VDS and may participate in the regatta.

1.1 Optimist Berthing

The Optimist boats are parked at two locations to the East of the main clubhouse. Due to ramp constraints, we have devised a strategy that will allow a more seamless launching and recovery process. The process will be explained at the Competitor's Briefing on 28 May at the Lawn. It is crucial for sailors, parents and coaches to cooperate with us so that all can have an enjoyable and successful regatta.

1.2 Proper footwear

We cannot emphasize enough the importance of proper footwear and we will be repeating this throughout. Sailors are **required** to wear their booties during the launching and recovery process. While we will have first aiders on standby for emergencies, we do not want to risk any injuries that could easily be prevented with proper footwear.



1.3 Washing Points

Water hoses have been prepared along the berthing route and at the boat park. It would be helpful for traffic control that sailors wash their equipment at the washing points located nearer to the boat park so as to not congest the limited runway.

2 CLUB FACILITIES

2.1 Shower Rooms

There are two separate shower rooms available at the club. One being the member's air-conditioned restroom located near the Pool Deck and the other for visitors located at the main clubhouse. During the RMOR weekend, both shower facilities will be available for participants to use. **Please note that for sailors training the weekend and week before the RMOR, only the visitor shower rooms are open for use.**

2.2 F&B Outlets

Food options are plenty; we have 3 outlets for F&B – [Marina Bistro](#), [Captain's Table Chinese Restaurant](#) and the [Discovery Pub](#). All our outlets are open to public while RM members are entitled to special rates.

2.3 Swimming Pool

The pool is open to sailors during RMOR, pool rules are to be adhered to at all times. Proper attire and pool etiquette must be observed. There will be no lifeguard on duty.

A maximum of 50 persons is allowed at any one time.

Failure to abide by these rules will result in closure of the pool usage to Club's discretion.
